



Parent/carer home school agreement

On our website there is an extensive Oasis Community Learning home/school agreement document. For ease and your convenience, while that document is the one that all Oasis Community Learning Schools adhere to, we have summarised it for ease of use.

If your child(ren) attend/s Oasis Academy Pinewood you agree to the following partnership working:

- Staff at Pinewood will treat you with respect, not raise their voices or use abusive language with you in line with the Oasis ethos and 9 Habits and we expect parents/carers to do the same. You understand that if raised voices, threats or abusive language are used then you may lose the right to enter the building or grounds and other action may be taken
- You agree to work within all school policies and procedures the school and Oasis Community Learning have
- You will send your child to school ready to learn with all equipment needed (e.g iPad, PE kit, reading book, school uniform). If you are unable to do so for any reason you will inform the school and we will do our best to support you and may be able to help. Children must not be sent to school with toys, sweets or other items that are not permitted
- You will work with us to support your child to complete the reading and any homework set
- Parents/carers must park/drive legally and safely on the roads and entrances near to the school
- Any complaints or concerns about anything in relation to your child's education and care you will raise it in the correct way, at an appropriate time with your child's class teacher in the first instance. If they feel it should be escalated to your child's phase lead, the assistant principal, deputy principal or principal then they will do so. We want to work together in partnership with you to solve any concerns or complaints you may have and we care about your feedback
- Racist, homophobic, sexist, transphobic and other discriminatory language or behaviours against children, staff or parents/carers are not tolerated and appropriate action will be taken
- All parents/carers must follow the absence reporting policy. All children will attend school unless they are too unwell to do so. If they are unwell a phone call on each day of absence must be made to the school office. Children must come to school on time every day. If you are running late in an exceptional circumstance, you must notify the school office
- In any school, if there is a safeguarding concern about a child there is a legal duty by the school to report this to children's social care. Any parent/carer that sends their child to school must have an understanding of this. As a school we understand that this can be extremely distressing for families however the safeguarding of children is the priority



- Parents/carers must keep up to date with communications from the school. These are mostly sent in the form of emails, messages on MCAS and in exceptional circumstances on paper letters. Please check for these regularly. If you change your contact details, you must inform the school immediately
- Oasis Academy Pinewood provide a range of events for parents/carers to attend to support you to help your children but there are also a range of social events. Please do where possible, attend these
- Payments for trips/visits etc must be made on time. If for whatever reason you are unable to do this, please notify the school well before the deadline and we will do our best to support you. Parents/carers should not blame the school if they miss a deadline
- Every child that attends Oasis Academy Pinewood is provided with an iPad to use to support their learning at school and at home. All parents/carers sign an agreement when their child's iPad is issued. This includes a guarantee that parents/carers pay for breakages. No parent/carer can refuse to do so. Breakages must be paid for. Payment plans can be set up upon request and where a family is genuinely struggling to pay this must be communicated to the school via the office.
